Assessment:

Applications will be assessed on the following guidelines:

- **Professional attitude** - behaviour and approach to racing and outside activities not necessarily associated with motorcycle sport.
- **Ability** - not necessarily based on results, but potential ability and future
- **Presentation** – able to ensure continued professionalism and be well-groomed at all times, both on and off the track.
- **Dedication and Commitment** - to achieve their goals.
- **Under 25 years of age**
- **Attitude and sociability** – on and off the track
- **Non factory-contracted** – or non factory-backed satellite rider at time of application

Assessment Panel:

The assessment panel will consist of representatives from the following:

- Motorcycle Industry
- Motorcycle Media
- Motorcycling Australia

Scholarship Support Package:

A 12 month support package will be provided for the Scholarship recipient to assist them to compete in the Australian Superbike Championship Series, for the following year.

Conditions of Scholarship

The conditions for accepting the Reece Bancell Scholarship are:

- Rider will sign a 12-month contract with suppliers if required
- Rider will agree to contest the full Scholarship year
- Rider agrees to perform at his best at all times and will ensure all relevant sponsors are always represented and promoted in a professional manner
- Scholarship can be withdrawn at any time for any breach of the assessment guidelines and all scholarship items to be returned, within 7 days of notice of intention to withdraw.
